Basic Life Support , Advance Life Support, and Pediatric Life Support Online Guidelines

<p>Part 1- Online Classroom Portion Employees whose job description require BLS, ACLS, and PALS will need to register via Fax. To register via fax go to the education page under departments on the Beacon and choose Education, then choose AHA forms, click on the last form in the list and print, check Heartcode and which discipline(BLS, ACLS or PALS)and fax. You must obtain a book in the Professional Practice and Development office for reference. Once you have received a passing score for part 1, you will simply print the certificate of completion for presentation at the skills check-off, part 2. Part 1 online takes approximately 1.5 hours for completion for BLS and 4 - 8 hours for completion of ACLS and PALS.</p> <p>Part 2-Inperson Skills Check-Off Skills check-off will be scheduled through the Professional Practice and Development Office and completed with a certified AHA instructor. Practice stations will be available prior to skills demonstration.
